Edible Landscapes of Yamhill County

- OCF grant meeting
 - Met with partner organizations on Jan 30 to establish high-level plans
 - Meeting again on Feb 22 to continue discussions
 - Jeri has ELoYC discussed Plastic Project art on garden boxes? Charlene Not yet

ZWM Projects & Reports

Sustainable Arts Festival

- Haven't received an answer from Recology yet
- Artists have been reaching out wondering what the plan is
- June 1 is set aside at the Bindery if we can make something happen

Plastics Project

- TPP has been included in Recology recycling guide this year
- Recology has been increasingly more responsive
- Getting more organized with leadership
- TPP looking for a new place to meet that will have more room, growing
- Strategizing to figure out where money and effort is best spent
- Hoping that ZW and TPP will put more effort into fundraising this year
- Local groups have been approaching TPP to collaborate on plastic collection
 - Coop ministries
 - First baptist
 - o Garden Club
- Desire to increase public education
- Tracking diversion rates better
- Friendsview retirement in Newburg has developed a recycling club with 103 households
- In Eugene, they have recycling "hubs"
- Public spot on KLYC to advertise collection event
- Keith added TPP contacts to Mailchimp audience and "tagged" them appropriately
- Farmers market
 - Suggestion to have TPP and ZW in one booth
 - John Rickert would like to join with his organization "Healthcare for All"
 - Not sure this is the best idea, not enough room for three orgs
 - TPP willing to try a combined booth to see if it works, trial period
 - o Ramsey will ask MDA if there's wiggle room on a bigger tent
 - Suggestion made to not allow John to join our tent, not applicable to our mission
- Would like to start applying for grants
- Starting an internship program
 - Desire to train people about what we're doing to continue the mission long term
 - o Ad placed in the MAC HS newsletter, and Sheridan
 - This is a trial idea to see where it develops and leads to
- Three workshops scheduled for this spring
 - From Tupperware to Mason jars
 - Creating a ripple in the community
 - o Plastics 101

- Field trip to Salem to tour their recycling facility and a place that deals with agricultural waste, called Agri-plas
- Garden club is taking the lead on a plastic cap art installation
- Has contacted the art alliance of yamhill county. Haven't heard back
 - Charlene is going to get some contact information for TPP
- Thoughts on merch for TPP?
 - o Haley it has to be done well or not at all
 - o Idea to reuse tshirts or other items to make our own merch
- Interested in ordering buttons to wear at events
 - o Found a company that make plastic free buttons
 - .35 or .40 cents each depending on size, min order 100
 - These would be to give away to the public and for volunteers to wear
 - Motion made to order 200 buttons, approved
- Seeking reimbursement for \$300 in expenses
 - Enrolled in 7-week course about plastic pollution starting April 17
 - Help wanted ad in the News Register
 - Food for volunteers at collection event
 - Guidebooks to sell and/or give away
 - Steve provided clarification on how reimbursements should work need some approval from the board over \$50
 - o Motion made for reimbursement, unanimously approved

Events

- Formed an events committee
- Met with Doris MDA to talk about Farmers market
 - Signup forms have not been distributed yet

Chapul Farms

- Grant to deal with McMinnville food waste
 - \$1500 from grant for ZW to put together a final report
 - PR
 - Show concrete results
 - Will work with Chapul to put this together

Standards Project

- Results are back, none of the projects will work in their system
 - Results are suspect
 - Photos show whole items thrown into their compost
 - Only 90 days
 - Not shredded like they should have been
- Results from Chapul are promising
 - Flies take 7 days
 - o Caveat requires an exact mixture for it work efficiently
- Taste of India has a desire to be more eco-friendly
- Hoping to have more information from the City and recology by the time we have our strategic retreat
