# **Approval of Minutes**

• The minutes of the previous meeting were unanimously approved as distributed.

## **Treasurer's Report**

- Donation update
  - Winner of ebike raffle donated \$1,500
- Unofficial proposal to reserve about \$4,400 to help bring community up to speed with new policy changes
- Ebike raffle brought in almost \$7,000
  - Suggested that the board vote on moving this into the general account

• In total, \$25,672.00 in all accounts; with \$2085.41 available to be transferred from PayPal.

# **Partner Organization Reports**

**Edible Landscapes of Yamhill County** 

- Received a \$33k grant from the Oregon Community Foundation
  - Install several community gardens around Yamhill County
  - o Partner with Head Start, Mac HS, and others
  - Meeting on December 5 to start planning
  - Been communicating with other community garden organizations in the Portland area for information
  - Suggestion to look into new federal grants that are multi-million dollars
    - Build a food forest in Yamhill County
    - Hire a coordinator
    - These forests could act as parks to grow food for the community
    - Public lands
    - We would need two nonprofit partners, such as YCAP

# **ZWM Projects & Reports**

Sustainable Arts Festival

- Committee has been meeting
  - o Committee is composed of Haley, Nora, Joan, Carla, and possibly Joan
- Idea change venue of Festival to a vacant hotel or rent a room
  - Possibly the Mac Theater hotel or the McMinnville Inn
- New vendors have been found for the Art Festival
- Question are vendors determined based on product price points?
  - Ramsey will talk with vendors to agree on set price point range
- Suggestion to try and get "lemonade day" on the same day as Art Festival

# Plastic Project

- Gerry Hunter is working on a pilot project
  - o "Forever ware" for takeout
  - Subscription-based system
- Compostable products being tested
- Second Saturday of February (10th) is the next Plastic Project event

#### **Events**

- Suggestion to form a sub-committee (w/ Sheila and Linda) to make the Farmer's Market completely compostable; Steve to take lead
  - Work with the food vendors
  - Ensure we have the right products to recommend to the vendors
  - Question will this raise the cost for the vendors?
    - Yes, it will always be more, but sometimes not much more
    - Some products will be going away with the new policies anyway
- Look into having a ZWM booth at the UFO Festival
- There is a new president of the IPNC
- Can collection for fundraising
  - Treasurer reports that there is another \$2k we have from recycling cans that can be added to our budget
  - Calculations show that there is roughly \$70k in cans/bottles from local businesses that are not collected that we could tap into
    - Collection would be a "full time" job
    - Gerry suggests that this could place a burden on employees. He also raises the concern of theft.
    - Collection would have to be consistent (every day or two)
    - What about the residential stream of cans/bottles?

## **Chapul Farms**

- Farm is going "gangbusters"; some huge grant wins
- Food waste trial has been very successful
  - Modular system in a container that will go to five farms (low income) across the country
  - \$1.7 million for this project

- Suggestion to form a subcommittee to review and improve dinner for next year
- Ultimate take-away is that there is a difference between Volunteer Appreciation
   Dinner and the Annual Fundraiser Dinner
- We will resume our review of this later in the spring

# **Guest Speaker Preparation**

- Starting in January
- Suggestion to add Adrian Chitty to the speaker line-up
  - Works for A-Z as sustainability coordinator
  - Is on IWAC board with Jackson Wines
  - Steve has talked with Adrian and he is interested in speaking
- Other guest speakers are Haley Queen, Chapul, Recology, and the Plastic Project
- Suggestion to see if Bottle Drop would be interested in speaking; community still
  has questions about how Bottle Drop works
- Start advertising
  - Haley will be posting on the website and socials
  - Need topics, information, and pictures/graphics

#### Consolidation of Lists

- Susan working on compiling a database that everyone will have access to
  - o Current lists are scattered; will consolidate and categorize into a spreadsheet
  - Everyone needs to send all lists with names and phone #s to Susan within the next week
  - Suggested that rather than updating lists before sending, send them to
     Susan and then everything can be updated in the CRM afterwards
  - Include: First name, last name, phone #, email, and mailing address

#### **ZWM Strategic Retreat**

- Location should be local
  - o Ramsey's house
  - Rent an AirBnB (possibly Wortman House?)
  - Back room of the Atticus Hotel
- Maybe show movies and have food (takeout)
- Have partners come address our group, such as Mac Habitat
- We need to set goals for what we want to achieve at this retreat
- Suggestion to form a committee to discuss and plan this retreat

- The dates of February 13-14 were proposed and appear to work for most
- Ramsey will check with the Wortman House (across from Foreland Beer)
- Suggested that we meet an hour early (4pm) for the next board meeting on January
   8th to further discuss and plan this retreat

# New Logo

- Haley has designed a new logo and is in the process of incorporating it into all ZWM channels
- Question is there a style guide or official letterhead?
  - Not currently
  - Susan will work with Haley on standardization of our marketing style guide
  - Will have something completed and ready to present to the group at the strategic retreat

- Duties include taking notes, sending out minutes, maintaining bylaw compliance and coordinating organization
